**Subject: Support SCA 10 – Public employee retirement benefits**

Dear Senator Moorlach:

On behalf of the City of Huntington Beach, I am writing to express our support for SCA 10, which prohibits public employers from increasing retirement benefits for their employees without two-thirds voter approval.

This constitutional amendment does not prohibit public employees from receiving additional retirement benefits; it simply requires voter approval before they are increased. This is a common-sense measure that puts power back into the hands of the taxpayer. With pension liability spiraling out of control, it is important to give the taxpayer the ability to be influential and allow them to decide how their taxpayer money should be spent.
